

Definition of the Church

The External Means Or Aids

- Because of our weakness ("prison house of our flesh")
- God's grace and accommodation

By Which God Invites Us Into The Society Of Christ


- We are eligible, through the gospel, to be one with Christ
- Fellowship/union with Christ is accomplished in the church

And Holds Us Therein

- Not only salvation but perseverance as well
- · Nurtured by the church in our sanctification
- God's blessings are mutually bestowed upon the church
 - · God could work without the church, but we cannot.
 - Individual Christians cannot opt out of these outward benefits
 - The Reformed corrective is not "no church" but a more true church

The Nature of the Church

- The Invisible Church –
 An Object of faith
 - · All of the elect
 - · Above time/space
 - Without corruption/hypocrisy
- The Visible Church
 - An Object of Experience
 - A Mixture of elect/nonelect
 - · Limited to present time
 - · A Mixture of devotion/treason



The Nature of the Church

- The True Church
 - · Where is it?
 - · Where the Bishop is (RC)
 - · Where godliness/holiness is (Anabaptists)
 - Where Christ is (Calvin)
 - Marks
 - · Preaching of the Word (vernacular)
 - · Sacraments duly instituted/administered
- Discipline not a mark
 - · Marks are objective elements
 - Discipline is a subjective response
 - Positive discipling as well as punitive correction.
 - Compared to the sinews of the human body – holding it together.
 - Aim
 - · Preserves God's honor
 - · Protects the good from wicked
 - Leads offender to repentance
 - Steps
 - Private warning
 - · Public admonition
 - · Exclusion from communion

The Nature of the Church

- The True Church
 - Marks
 - Preaching of the Word
 - · Sacraments duly administered
 - If marks are missing, Christ is absent

- · RCs reject Protestants
- · Calvin does not reject RCs similarly
 - · "a faction of wicked men"
 - · Still, "traces of the church" remain

- · "Even if swarming with faults"
 - In points of nonessential doctrine or practice (rf. Cor. Ch.) (Essential: Unity/triunity of God, Christ's deity, salvation based on grace through faith, etc.)
 - Opposing the Anabaptists here who sought a pure, perfect church without error in doctrine or profession of faith.
- RC Church?
 - · Papacy contrary to church order
 - But traces remain baptism, remnant, etc.
